LOCAL ARCHITECTURE FIRM K.H. WEBB HONORED

Vail, Colorado—Two homes designed by local architecture firm K.H. Webb were featured as the cover image of the two most recent issues of LUXE Magazine, a quarterly journal that showcases luxury residential architecture, design, interiors and products. The magazine serves as an idea book and resource of fine architectural design, interiors and trends. LUXE Magazine carefully selects four homes from throughout Colorado to feature in each issue. “I am very proud of our team. The magazine’s most recent issue features a project that K.H. The exterior of this home combined an eclectic mix of materials (cedar and mountain ash stone blended with aluminum channels and steel girders) that included a small sod patch on the roof that blooms into wildflowers in the summer. By combining diverse textures and materials K.H. Webb created an interior that is modern, but still radiates warmth. For example, the fireplace featured on the cover, made of mountain ash stone and sparkling mosaic tiles, incorporates soothing elements of nature.

K.H. Webb’s design for Vernon and Amy Faulconer’s home high atop Beaver Creek was featured on the cover of the Fall 2008 issue of LUXE Magazine. It took inspiration from the historic Timberline Lodge on Mount Hood in Oregon and utilized a stunning hexagonal timberframe as the art of the building, while allowing a clean interior to be the blank canvas for the owner’s contemporary art collection. The Faulconers brought an adventurous spirit to conjuring their vacation home resulting in unique accents such as a luscious wedge of translucent caramel onyx for the powder room sink and countertops, and smooth, green soapstone panels for the family room fireplace.
